



Clean surfaces to Sunset Boulevard

Last week, more than 300m² concrete facades were cleaned and are now completely free from algae and other kinds of dirt from air pollution.

Pollution from the air

It is mainly filth from the highway and algae from the nearby nature that caused the building to become green and gray on the surfaces, a problem which is well known throughout the country to non-impregnated facades.
